REGISTRATION AND ENTRY

To register for each competition you must arrive in good time to pay and register within the allotted time (17:30 – 18:00). Participants are encouraged to warm up before coming to the centre as no one will be allowed to climb on the wall until the competition starts. There will be easier problems for each category for warm ups.

Registration forms will be available from reception at the time of entry.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The league will run similar to other bouldering leagues found across the country. Each leg will offer the chance to accumulate as many points as possible through attempting the numbered problems as appropriate to your category.

Your four best scores will count towards your league standing. 'For fun' entrants will get points but as these categories are not intended for the competition standings a league status will not be given.

THE LEAGUE IS TAILORED TO BE ACCESSIBLE FOR EVERYONE FROM NEW CLIMBERS JUST
STARTING OUT THROUGH TO ELITE
SO THERE'S NO EXCUSE NOT TO COME ALONG AS YOU'LL PROBABLY WIN SOMETHING OUT
OF THE RAFFLE!

Each entrant is to pay £4 over the price of entry for each leg of the league they enter in. This is to go towards raffle and cash prizes. Normal entry fees are; £6 for registered climbers aged 17yrs and above and £4.50 for registered climbers aged 13 to 16yrs. Non registered climbers are required to pay £1.50 for day registration.

EACH LEG WILL RUN AS FOLLOWS:

10:00 to 17:30 – Climbing Centre Closed for route setting

17:30 to 18:00 – Registration and entry

18:15 to 21:30 – Competition

21:45 to 22:00 – Prize giving/raffle

At the end of each leg there will be a raffle of prizes once score cards have been taken in. At the end of the final competition there will be cash prize presentations for the top three standings in each league.

RULES

There will be novelty problems at each event so beware! Rules will be available on the night and judges available if you have any questions regarding the problems.

All problems are sit starts unless otherwise marked as standing starts (Stand). Sit starts mean that your hands and feet are on the wall/holds and your bum is the last part of your body off the matt. Kick/push starts are NOT allowed.

Start using both hands on the hold marked SS or one hand on each of the two holds marked S.

Unless marked otherwise stated smearing on the ply panels and bridging is allowed for both hands and feet. Volumes and features on the wall are only to be used if marked on the problem (+Feat).

Problems marked AF allow for all holds for feet.

Finishing holds of problems will be marked FF for a matching hand finish or two separate holds each marked F. The finishing holds may be the top of the wall, feature or bolt on hold as marked.

All of the above will be marked at the bottom/ start of the route and on the score sheet.

Scores are marked as follows:

Completed on	1 st Attempt – 10 points
	2 nd Attempt – 7 points
	3 rd Attempt – 5 points

Only three attempts are allowed per problem.

Once you have attempted a problem please respect others and wait your turn.

Score sheets are marked by each participant. We would strongly advise against cheating as there will be plenty other people and judges there to smite you down if caught!!!

IF IN DOUBT: ASK
